Internship Opportunity

The Media & Communications Intern supports the Executive Director in designing all communications, both online and print. The intern will create, develop, and maintain content for various social media platforms. Responsibilities span a range of communication tasks, including parent and professional interviews, updating SavingTeens blog, and researching social media trends. The position is unpaid and 100% remote via computer and phone.

Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled college student
- Knowledge of therapeutic programs preferred but not required
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Excited about the SavingTeens mission
- Familiarity with social media strategies and platforms
- Social media savvy
- Strong organization and time management skills
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office programs
- Detail oriented
- Knowledge of video editing tools
- Ability to complete a minimum of 16 hours of work per week

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Interview volunteers, professionals, and families (as assigned). Write short articles for website, email blasts, and social media outlets.
- 2. Update social media platforms with new content, photos, links to resources, etc.
- 3. Monitor postings to ensure brand message is constant from the terminology used to images posted
- 4. Interact with followers and potential donors by communicating and answering questions through the company's social pages
- 5. Assist in the growth of the brand by raising awareness through various social media platforms.
- 6. Analyze and report on social media statistics
- 7. Writing copy for social media channels in several predetermined content categories.
- 8. Update organizational information and imagery on social media channels and other online listings.
- 9. Plan content and schedule posts through the end of 2021 on social media channels.
- 10. Assist with special projects and events as assigned.
- 11. Virtual internship. Candidate must have access to the internet, a computer, and phone.
